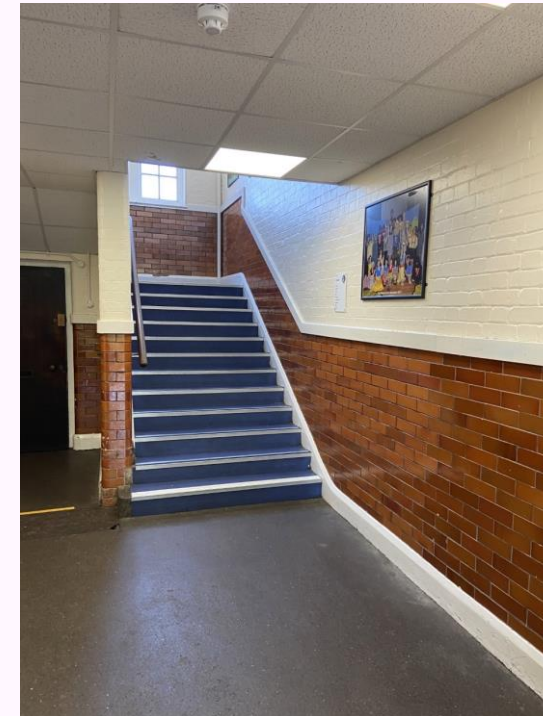
E27-E31 Use the

Coats and rainy weather

Twice weekly lateral flow testing

This is a big change. To help reduce infections we need you to keep doing your twice weekly lateral flow tests.
