### 1. School's Commitment to the Parents and Student

- be receptive to any concerns, complaints or issues which parents or children wish to raise and let parents know promptly of any concerns the school has about their children's work or behaviour;
- contact parents as soon as is reasonable if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment;
- send home school Progress Reports;
- arrange Parents' Evenings to discuss the progress of children;
- keep parents informed regularly about the school's activities and special events through newsletters, notices, letters and the website.

### 2. Parental Commitment to the School

I will

- see that my child attends school regularly in the correct uniform, on time, properly equipped, with a suitable bag, and ready to learn. I will inform the school promptly of absence;
- let the school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour and be receptive to concerns raised by the school;
- support the school's policies and guidelines on behaviour and encourage my child to keep the school rules;
- ensure that my child undertakes regular homework as set by the school and encourage other opportunities for home learning;
- attend Parents' Evenings and discussions about my child's progress whenever possible;
- take a keen interest in my child's life at school.

- attend school regularly and on time and obey the school rules;
- wear the school uniform and be tidy in appearance in school **and to and from school**;
- bring all the equipment I need every day in a suitable bag;
