

## Year 7 Curriculum 2020 – 21

The curriculum at LCHS will have areas of similarity to the experience of students from primary school, but there will also be a lot of new and exciting experiences as well. The foundation of our curriculum is built on the principles of our intent statement.

### LCHS Curriculum Intent

Our curriculum is designed to challenge all students to **achieve**, what for them, is individual **excellence** and to be the vehicle for delivering deep social **justice**. We are fiercely ambitious and our curriculum reflects this **passion** to provide academic rigour whilst ingraining a strong sense of **moral** purpose in the **character** of our students.

### What will I study in Year 7?

Over the past few weeks and months we have put a lot of thought into the curriculum for our new Year 7 intake in September 2020. This is an intake like no other, an intake with a completely different experience of Year 6 than any other that has come before. To this end, we have adapted the curriculum slightly to reflect this experience.

Our school day has five one hour lessons and therefore 25 lessons over the period of one week. This means that your timetable will have the following combination of lessons over the course of a week.

English – 4 lessons	Maths – 4 lessons	Science – 3 lessons
History – 1 lesson	Geography – 1 lesson	Modern Foreign Languages - 2 lessons
Religious Studies – 1 lesson	Physical Education – 2 lessons	Art – 2 lessons
Music – 1 lesson	Drama – 1 lesson	Design Technology – 1 lesson
Information and Communication Technology – 1 lesson	Building Learning Power – 1 lesson	

A big difference for all students will be the adventure of having a timetable and moving around the school for five different lessons everyday. This is not something to worry about as all of the other members of our school community will help you to get to your class if you are not sure where to go.

All students will study a Modern Foreign Language (MFL) and students will be allocated either German or Spanish as their language to study. We will send some information home about MFL and where students have prior experience of these languages, we will endeavour to continue their journey in this language.
