

What is the Catch Up Premium?

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2).

Here at Lincoln Christ's Hospital School we use this funding to ensure that students who did not achieve a level 4 in reading or/and maths receive additional tuition in literacy and numeracy to improve their levels, enabling them access the wider curriculum and to close the gap between them and their peers.

Funding is spent on:

- Individual tuition
- Intensive small-group tuition
- Funding of resources and materials

In the academic Year 2015-16 we have received £27,000 Catch Up Premium.
